DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

RESTRAINTS

DO NOT exceed 3 m between bait stations for mice, or 9 m for rats.

DO NOT place baits in open.

BAITING STRATEGY:

Use only in caulking gun. Apply 3-4 grams of bait (two pumps of the gun) to the base of a waxed rodent bait box. Place baited boxes in protected situations away from hot pipes, ovens etc.

- Eliminate as far as practicable, all alternative food sources.
- Inspect baits daily.
- Replace eaten baits. If eaten quickly, increase number of baits.
- Continue observation and replenishment until no more baits are taken.
- Baiting for at least 2 weeks is necessary to reduce rat/mouse numbers.

The use of this product for the control of protected native rodents requires permission from wildlife authorities.

PRECAUTION: Do not allow bait to contaminate foodstuffs or food intended for human or animal consumption. Do not apply bait to crops.

Place baits in locations which are inaccessible to other animals and birds. This product is hazardous to pigs, cats, dogs and poultry.

PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT: DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used containers. The product is restricted to use in and around buildings (within 2 metres) or enclosed spaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in the closed, original container in a cool, well-ventilated area. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Break, crush, puncture and bury empty containers and dispose of unused bait in a local authority landfill. If not available bury the containers or unused bait below 500mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt. DO NOT use containers which have held bait for any other purpose.

Dispose of carcasses safely by burning or burying in an approved landfill.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS: Poisonous if absorbed by skin contact or swallowed.

Repeated minor exposure may have a cumulative poisoning effect. Avoid contact with skin. Do not touch bait. When using the product wear rubber gloves. If on skin and after each baiting, wash thoroughly with soap and water.
